I have known Bro. David and Mrs. Beth for more than 22 years. During the first several years, Bro. Thank you for taking the time to consider our ministry for presentation in your church and for monthly financial partnership with us.

My family and I have been missionaries in Guatemala, Central America for over 17 years. During that time the Lord has allowed us to be involved in various ministries, several of which will be presented in this brochure. But first allow me to share my testimony.

My Testimony of Salvation

I was raised in a Christian home and grew up in Baptist churches. As a young boy of seven, I made a profession of faith while my parents were serving as missionaries in Mexico. Although I had lived an exemplary "Christian" life, I had many doubts about my salvation.

At the age of 18, there was a tremendous struggle going on within my heart. Satan tried to get me to keep on being a "good Christian" - but the Lord impressed upon my heart that if I didn't accept Him as my Savior that night, that He would not give me another chance. During the invitation, I gave my heart to the Lord completely and accepted Him as my personal Savior. I have had no doubts since.

My Testimony of Call to the Ministry

Shortly thereafter, the Lord began dealing with me concerning full-time Christian service. He had blessed me with musical talent, and I felt that He might have me to go into the music ministry.

While attending college, I had the opportunity to go to Mexico on a mission trip. While on that trip, the Lord showed me in a very personal way that He did want me to use my musical abilities, but first and foremost, He wanted me to be a preacher of the Gospel on the foreign field. I surrendered my life to the Lord for full-time service in March of 1987.

After serving in my home church for 2-1/2 years as Music and Youth Director, my family and I were sent out as missionaries to Guatemala, where we have been serving since 1991.

How can we contact the Lotts?


