Preacher's Camp

This year's annual preacher's camp was a special blessing as we had **Australian Evangelist Gil Anger** as our speaker to teach on Spiritual Gifts. There were just over **200 teenagers** that attended the camp. The theme of the camp was **"How to Behave Yourself in the House of God"** based on I Timothy 3:15. I basically taught a good portion of I Timothy with a focus on young people and their service in the context of the local church. During those few days there were **25 professions of faith and 7 young men answered the call to preach.** Praise the Lord!

More Baptisms in Villa Nueva

Shortly before leaving Guatemala, I had the privilege of **baptizing 5 new believers** at our second work, Abundant Life Baptist Church. What a joy to see this work go forth and continue to grow on its own! Continue to pray for this work as **they are awaiting the approval of their building permit** for the construction of their own church building!

Transmission Troubles...Again

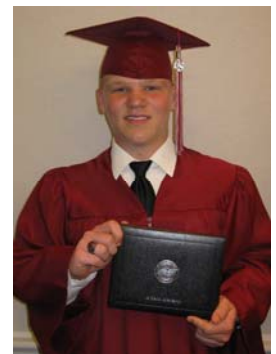
About a month before leaving Guatemala for furlough, the transmission went out on our van, which is the vehicle that we had planned on using for furlough. We had the transmission repaired in Guatemala at a cost of \$1700.00 and it appeared to be in good shape. The entire cost was paid for by offerings from our third church (Truth Baptist Mission) and our home church in Texas. We are very grateful to both of them for their sacrifice.

However, we had additional trouble with the transmission while coming through Mexico. Some sensors had to be replaced, but it still did not correct the problem. After arriving in Texas, a Chrysler transmission mechanic checked it out and the "overhaul" done in Guatemala had not been a complete one (then apparently did not touch 3rd and 4th gears). It now appears to be fixed properly, but **the additional repair cost was \$1500.00.** This has put a great strain on our finances. Pray that this need will be met soon.

Jonathan's Graduation

Our oldest son Jonathan was 6-months-old when we arrived in Guatemala. **On May 10th, Jonathan graduated from A Beka Christian Academy.**

He also received a Presidential Award for Outstanding Academic Achievement. We are grateful to the Lord for this milestone in Jonathan's life.
