Although we didn’t have much time to promote it, we had our largest crowd to date, without inviting other churches. **On February 22nd, we had 54 in attendance, with 20 visitors present.** Since that Sunday, we have had visitors for most of our services, including our Wednesday night Bible study. Although most of these visitors already profess to be saved, several of them do not. Please pray that many of these who have heard the Gospel will make decisions to trust Christ as their Savior in the near future.



9th Annual Preacher’s Camp – Evangelist Ken Lynch

While we were in the States on furlough, I did not send out letters – just emails - about this year’s camp. Due to the fact that many who normally attend do not have emails, I was unsure as to how many we would have this year. The Lord blessed in spite of the facts, and we wound up with **76 in attendance** for this year’s camp, including almost 20 new guys.

I personally felt that this camp was an important camp, as the theme was **“Sing Unto the Lord a New Song”**. Evangelist **Ken Lynch** did a wonderful job of teaching on Biblical principles and guidelines for music in the church, and the teaching was well received with many good and pertinent questions being asked and answered from a Biblical viewpoint. Thank you, Bro. Lynch, for an excellent job!



During Bro. Lynch’s stay, he also preached in 6 other Baptist churches, plus held a one-day evangelistic service entitled **“One More For Christ”**. We had an attendance of about 500, including brethren from about 10 different Baptist churches in the Guatemala City area. **Two precious souls trusted Jesus as their Savior, and several more rededicated their lives to the Lord!**
